






Investing in the Workforce

Enhancing Skills and Knowledge

This school year, Wonders Professional Development Consortium facilitated a comprehensive program for professional growth. Through the PDC, Wonders educators completed 18 - 24 hours of professional training, enhancing their skills and knowledge to benefit the children and families of Wonders programs and grow their skills as educators. In addition to benefiting Wonders educators, the PDC extended its reach to provide professional development opportunities to meet the needs of the wider educational community. Through the PDC, a total of 120 regional educators participated in our Professional Development Workshop Series, a series of 11 virtual workshops led by PDC trainers, and successfully hosted the Intentional Out-of-School-Time Environments Conference for 30 Maryland educators who each completed 6 hours of training in a day dedicated to skill-building and professional growth. This year was a remarkable opportunity to foster collaboration and learning within our professional community.

Wonderspalooza


Spring 2024!
